

# **Report of Activities of An Nusrat Foundation for Year 2019 and 2020 presented at the Virtual Board of Trustee/RMT/Stakeholders Meeting held on 27th December 2020 via Zoom HD Meeting.**

## **6.0 Preamble**

## **6.12 Introduction**

This is the report of activities of An Nusrat Foundation for the period between December 9th 2018 and 27th December 2020. The report includes the activities of the foundation vis a vis the request for financial assistance, disbursement of donated funds for the sick, the needy and indigent Muslims including special interventions (palliatives) during the Covid -19 pandemic in the period under review. It is a two year report because the board was unable to meet in 2019 due to circumstances beyond her control.

## **6.2 Board of Trustee**

The board of trustee consist of 7 members since inception in 2014 and they have been diligent in managing the affairs of the foundation on behalf of the Muslim platform members in particular and all Muslims in general. The members of the board are Ustadh Rasheed Hashim, Babatunde Yousuph, Igho Abdhakeem, Abdullah Abdulateef (Assudaissy), Tade Shakir, Luqman Seriki and Hajia Majeedah Ashimi-Idris.

### **6.3 Regional Management Teams**

There was a two regional management team which was later merged into one for easy coordination. The management team is responsible for verification and confirmation of claims and request as well as follow ups on them after sending their recommendations to the board for approval and disbursement of funds. The regional management team increased from the previous numbers of 8 is now 13 with additional five members. The additional 5 members are Abdhakeem Inenemo, Abdulqudus Olalekan, Barr. Shehu AbdQadir AbdKareem, Sulaiman Playing and Hajia Radhiyah AbdKabir. These five new members volunteer to join the team. The RMT is head by Bro. AbdulKareem Babatunde Taiwo.

### **6.4 Administration and Management**

The foundation was coordinated by the board of trustees which designed the modalities of operation and supported by the regional management team. The foundation account with First Bank Plc has three signatories who also serve as account officer as well as finance team.

### **6.5 Media and Publicity**

The foundation maximised the wider reach of the social media platforms to generate funds for her various funds appeals. The social media appeals is majorly handle by Mal. Faruq Eseoghene (media officer) and been supported by the secretariat.

## **6.6 Bank**

The foundation maintained a current account with First Bank Plc Surulere shopping centre branch. The three accounts signatories are Luqman Seriki, Babatunde Nurudeen Yusuf and Umar Aderibigbe. All funds raised are deposited into this bank current **account No. 2024486563.**

## **6.7 Fund Generation/ Disbursement**

The foundation generates the greater percentage of her fund from public fundraising appeal on behalf of the sick and indigent through with the efforts of her publicity team on social media. Also, funds are generated through special donations, endowment and monthly pledge from all stakeholders and other Muslims although, these are not regularly paid.

The funds generated are disbursed to the needy after verification and validation of the claims by the RMT. The BoT usually deliberate on the report and approval of the disbursement of funds to the beneficiaries.

## **6.8 Request and Disbursement in 1440/1441(2019)**

There was little activities on Fundraising and approval of funds disbursement in 2019. Below is the account of disbursement and beneficiaries in 2019 as approved by the board. All disbursement are well documented with proof of payment and acknowledgement by the beneficiaries.

## **7.3 Special Interventions**

### **A. Covid -19 Ramadan Relief Package**

Worthy of mention are the special interventions and initiatives the foundation embarked on during the Covid - 19 pandemic relief package for indigent Muslims in 4 states ( Lagos,Oyo, Osun and Kwara) states respectively. Attached is the comprehensive report of the program.

### **B. Eidul Adha Private School Teachers Palliatives**

This was another special interventions to support the private schools teachers and teachers of Islamic Madrasah who shut out of work with the closure of schools due to corona Virus pandemic. The foundation with the assistance of Allah and then the support of many Muslims was able to raised and disbursed the sum of One Million, Four hundred and Thirty Thousand Naira only ( N1,430,000.00) to 281 Teachers in private schools and Islamic madrasah in 15 states of the country. We pray Allah reward all the donors and those who work for its success. Attached is the comprehensive report of the program.

## **7.4 Hospital/ Humanitarian Visitation**

The foundation w able to carry out her hospital/humanitarian visitation to a specialist general hospital asubiaro, Osogbo Osun State on 25th April,2019

The visitation was carried out in conjunction with members of Muslim Students' Society of Nigeria Osogbo Central branch led by Mal. Taofiq Olayoonu. Seven individuals 6 males and 2 females including two children participated in the visitation program.

The idea of humanitarian visitation to hospital was conceived and decided at the last annual stakeholders meeting of the foundation on 8th December 2017. Mal. Babatunde Yousuph was appointed as the national coordinator of AnNusrah Foundation hospital visitation team and was saddled with the responsibility of coordinating the programme. Gift packs which comprises of 4 tissue paper, 200ml dettol, 5 pieces of diapers and 2 medium size sachet of detergent soap numbering 100 packs was distributed to the patients and special gift delivered to the hospital management. Cash gift was donated to some needy for purchase of medicine and test during the visitation.

The sum of #130,000 was expended on for the visitation exercise. The visitation could not continue in the year and subsequent year due to paucity of funds and coronavirus pandemic. The team hope to continue in 2021 and more volunteers are been recruited to join the team.

### **7.5 Health Enlightenment Series**

An online health seminar group which was created on WhatsApp in 2018 for the purpose of enlightenment of the Muslim on health related issue still function well. There are 212 members in the group with 6 doctors providing enlightenment and answering questions on health issues in the group. We acknowledge the efforts of our doctors and pray Allah reward them abundantly Amin.

### **7.6 Special Fundraising**

A special Fundraising appeal was raised for the widows of one of the doctors in our health enlightenment group. Late Dr. Hassan Adeoti who died in May 2020 was of immense benefit to the Ummah and in conjunction with the deceased



family, friends and many other Muslims, the foundation was able to raised the sum of **N3,489.778.77**.All the funds raised was paid into a special account opened for the family and the foundation was part of the management of the Fund. We pray Allah forgive the late doctor and grant him paradise Amin.

### **7.7 Sustainability Efforts**

The foundation is working with Minhaj publicity on a branded item and e-commerce business opportunity that will generate additional funds for the sustainability of the foundation efforts. MoU has been drafted while our website has been optimized to support the business.

The BoT also received business proposal from some members of the public which are being deliberated upon in order to generate more fund for the foundation. Another efforts is reaching out to most beneficiaries of the foundation (especially the school proprietors and the teachers) to support the foundation with a certain amount to be paid on monthly basis as well as seeking financial assistance offline through letter of assistance to Muslim philanthropist. We pray all efforts to generate funds for the foundation come to fruition.

### **7.8 Land Donation**

The foundation received a kind gesture of donation of a plot of land in Ibadan Oyo State from a brother who once donated a land for maqbara to the foundation which did not come to reality. The foundation is already working on taking full possession of the land. We pray Allah reward our brother and accept it from him as act of Ibadah Amin.
